Answer: The story of God speaking to Moses out of the burning bush is found in Exodus 3:1—4:23. The burning bush as described in Exodus 3:2 is a theophany, the appearance of God in a form that is visible to man. The bush itself was most likely some kind of bramble or thorn bush, and the fire burning the bush was in the form of the angel of the Lord who "appeared to ...

Why did God speak to Moses out of the burning bush ...

The God in the burning bush is the God of Moses' forefathers, the God of the patriarchs, Israel's God. He is the God who made a covenant with Abraham and reiterated it to Isaac and Jacob.
